

Letter to the Bishop

This project is designed to show the Bishop who will confirm you that you are ready to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. The Bishop will read each letter and most of the time he responds to your letters during the homily during the Confirmation Mass.

Your letter must include the following information.

Address your Letter: Your Excellency,

Paragraph one: Introduce yourself. Your name, age, school, do you attend mass regularly and possibly add something personal: favorite subject in school a hobby or sport you like.

Paragraph two: What have you learned in class this year. Here is the time to impress him. What have you learned that really stuck with you? What have you learned that you have put into practice? What do you think the program?

Paragraph three: What do you expect to gain receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation? Look to the future. What are you aspiring to do with your life? How will the Sacrament help you attain your goals? How will you be a more active member of the church?

Remember, the Bishop will be reading these letters. Be honest when writing the letter. Take some time thinking of these questions before you put them down on paper. A final draft typed is due on January 29, 2022.
